The first area of the Museum is known as *The Alley*. Here you will see the first NASCAR race car driven by Bill Elliott, moonshine cars and a car driven by the late Casey Elliott, son of Sheila and Ernie Elliott and nephew of Bill Elliott. You will also see the car owned by Raymond Parks and driven by Lloyd Seay and the Gober Sosebee '39 Ford, which won Daytona 3 times.

Next, you will enter the *Saturday Night Drive-In Theater*, a period-themed "Drive In" experience where guests sit in old cars and on tailgates to view our movie made especially for the GRHOF telling of the evolution of stock car racing from moonshining and tripping down Hwy. 9 to Atlanta.

Step into The *Elliott Family Legacy Room* and view Bill's many trophies and awards. Learn more about Casey and the Elliott family history. Leaving the Legacy Room on your left you will see the many race cars including his 1988 Championship car. Don't miss the dynamometer built by Ernie Elliott.

The *Georgia Racing Hall of Fame Room* displays many of the men and women who made Georgia racing famous. Each year the GRHOF inducts 8 more racers into the Hall of Fame. Among its inductees are: Raymond Parks, Gober Sosebee, Bill Elliott, Jimmy Mosteller, Mickey Swims and Bud Lunsford.

Check out the old headlines in the *Georgia Racing Heritage* area that focus on all forms of racing and spotlights history and personalities.

Our *Display of Cars* includes YearOne's #59 race car and a Hot Rod show car.

Exhibits change monthly, so visit often.
